- 1. At least 61% of grade 3-8 students will score proficient/advanced on the ELA PSSA
- 2. At least 71% of grade 3 students will score proficient/advanced on the ELA PSSA
- 3. At least 36% of grade 3-8 students will score proficient/advanced on the Math PSSA
- 4. At least 59% of all students will attend school 95% of days or more
- 5. At least 29% of all students will attend school 90% of days or more
- 6. At least 99% of students will have zero out-of-school suspensions
