- 2. At least 77% of grade 3 students will score proficient/advanced on the ELA PSSA*
- 3. At least 36% of grade 3-8 students will score proficient/advanced on the Math PSSA*
- 4. At least 80% of all students will attend school 90% of days or more*
- 5. At least 99% of students will have zero out-of-school suspensions*
